About the show

Tauranga Musical Theatre is very excited to be staging *Dare to Dream Jr*. Celebrate 100 years of Disney music with this breathtaking musical revue.

The musical follows an eager group of trainees on their first day at a fictional Walt Disney Imagineering Studio. As the group sets out to help each other discover their dreams, they work together to explore the power of dreams to unite, inspire and make anything possible.

Dance Audition Call: Sunday 5th October 2025 from 11:00am – 12:00pm at Westside Theatre.

Tap Dance Audition Call: Sunday 5th October 2025 from 12:00pm to 12:30pm at Westside Theatre

(Everyone to attend the Dance Audition Call and those wanting to audition for Tap Dance to stay on for the Tap Dance Audition Call)

Callback: Sunday 5th October 2025 between 9:00am – 11:00am at Westside Theatre.

Audition timeslots may be extended through to Sunday 5th October 2025 only if required.

Preparation for auditions

Auditionees must be aged 10 - 18 (as at 24th January 2026) to be part of Dare to Dream Jr.

On the day, please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your audition time, already warmed up.

Please bring a backing track for your audition song (without vocals) on a USB or on your phone. We will provide backing track playback facilities for smart devices. Please prepare a short (approximately two minutes or less) musical theatre song of your own choosing that showcases your voice, range and character. Do not be offended if you do not get to sing all your prepared vocals. It does not mean you are not being considered. As part of your audition, you may also be asked by the creative team to sing a song from the show, so please be familiar with the song(s) sung by the character(s) you are auditioning for. Sheet music will be provided for this if required on the day.

You will also be asked to read a segment from the show opposite the Director or Assistant Director. It will be a cold read, so no need to prepare anything for this part of the audition. However, please make sure you read and familiarize yourselves with the character descriptions at the bottom of the pack.

Every auditionee must attend the dance call on Sunday morning, please arrive 15 minutes beforehand to warm up. There will also be a group warm up at the start of the dance call. Please wear comfortable, fitted clothes so that we can clearly see your movements. Appropriate footwear: Jazz shoes or sneakers. The dance will be taught to you during the audition.

We want to see the best version of you so there will be an improvisation section in the dance call for you to show us your style along with any tricks, kicks, leaps and jumps you may be able to do.

You will be auditioning before a panel consisting of the Director, Assistant Director, Musical Director, Choreographer and Production Manager.

Call backs

Please be prepared for the possibility of a call back. Timing will be dictated by the total number of those auditioning, but will be some time between 9:00am - 11:00am on Sunday the 5^{th} of October 2024. Getting a call back does not guarantee a role. Likewise, you may be cast even if you are not called back.

Please ensure that you have entered a contact telephone number on your audition application form where we can easily reach you during the audition dates.

- Tap Dance audition (those wishing to attend): 12:00pm 12:30pm Sunday 5th October 2025, at Westside Theatre, Tauranga;
- Callbacks: Sunday the 5th of October 2025 if required
- Rehearsals will begin with a read through Wednesday 8th October 2025 from 5:30pm-7:30pm and will be as follows:
- Wednesdays 5:30pm 7:30pm: From, 8th October 17th December 2025
- Thursdays 5:30pm 7:30pm: From 9th October 18th December 2025
- Sundays 9am 1pm: From 12th October 21st December 2025
- (Sunday rehearsals may be extended or time altered for 14th December and/or 21st December)
- There will be a break over the Christmas / New Year period from after rehearsal on Sunday 21st December 2025 until Sunday 4th January 2026, when we will begin rehearsing again.
- 1st rehearsal 2026- Sunday 4th January, then Wednesday 7th January 2026

Production expectations

Your participation in this production requires your undivided commitment in order to ensure a production of the highest possible quality. If cast, you cannot commit to any other production during the rehearsal period and production season. You should not audition if you are unable to commit to the rehearsal and production schedule. If you have any other commitments (personal or work) that may impact on your ability to attend rehearsals, you must provide full relevant details in your audition application. Not all performers will be required at all rehearsals, and rehearsals will be scheduled as carefully as possible to make the best use of your time.

Casting announcement

Performers will be notified by email or phone of the outcome of their audition as soon as possible following casting. Feedback will not be given. A full cast announcement will be subsequently made on the Tauranga Musical Theatre media channels.

All cast and crew are considered to be goodwill ambassadors for Tauranga Musical Theatre and for the show and we expect all cast and crew to meet that responsibility both in person and online. There will be a closed group Facebook page which cast and crew are encouraged to join and actively participate in.

Other information

All involved in this production will need to become a financial member of Tauranga Musical Theatre, and are required to agree and adhere to a code of conduct that covers health and safety, personal well being, and responsibilities to fellow cast and crew members.
